The applicant must be planning to attend a two-year or four-year college in order to be eligible for the scholarship. Applications and letters of recommendation must be postmarked on or before April 3, 2008.

Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable. The Junior League reaches out to women of all races, religions, and national origins who demonstrate an interest in and commitment to voluntarism.
