

Junior League of Greater Springfield Information Sheet

A. Description of Scholarship

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a female graduating senior of a greater Springfield area public, private, or parochial high school who has demonstrated outstanding volunteer service during her high school years.

The scholarship is to be awarded annually and is non-renewable.

Interested applicants must submit a completed application with the following four parts completed:

Part 1: The applicant must complete the information sheet and use it as the cover sheet for the application packet.

Part 2: The applicant must give concise answers to the scholarship questionnaire. Limit the response to the space provided for each question. *Do not attach any additional sheets.*

Part 3: The applicant must submit an essay on her volunteer experience. Limit your essay only to the space provided in Part 3. *Do not attach any additional sheets.*

Part 4: The applicant must also ensure that the following completed forms are included in the application package:

- a) JLGS Guidance Counselor Letter (Part 4A) completed by the applicant's high school guidance counselor.
- b) JLGS Volunteer Supervisor Letter (Part 4B) completed by the applicant's volunteer supervisor.

B. Eligibility Requirements/Criteria

- Female
- May or June graduate of a public, private, or parochial high school in one of the following cities/towns: Agawam, Chicopee, East Longmeadow, Hampden, Holyoke, Longmeadow, Ludlow, South Hadley, Springfield, West Springfield, and Wilbraham.
- Applicant must submit essay on volunteer experience.
- Educational plans: must plan to attend a two-year or four-year college program and provide written verification of college acceptance upon request.
- If eligibility status changes and the recipient does not continue education, scholarship money must be returned to the Junior League of Greater Springfield.
